DATES	EXTRA INFORMATION OF ACTIVITIES
Tues 23 rd / Wed 24 th July	Across these two days, the onsite arts and crafts will be inspired by the theme of animals and insects. We will also be engaging in different sporting activities such as dodgeball and rounders. The activities will begin 10am, pause during lunch between 12-1pm and resume until pick up time at 2pm.
Thurs 25 th July	The offsite trip to Hardwick Park will take place all day, a bus will collect kids and staff from TCCA car park at 9:30am. The day consists of Hardwick Park team leaders building dens and fires with the kids and allowing them time for free play on the grounds. (Lunch will be taken with the youth leaders to provide for the kids)
Tues 30 th / Wed 31 st July	Across these two days, the onsite arts and crafts will be inspired by the theme of the beach. We will also be engaging in different sporting activities such as football and athletics games. The activities will begin 10am, pause during lunch between 12-1pm and resume until pick up time at 2pm.
Thurs 1 st August	The offsite trip to Seaton Carew will take place all day, a bus will collect kids and staff from TCCA car park at 9:30am. The day consists of game and sporting equipment being used, allowing the kids to enjoy their free time on the beach in whatever way they choose. (Lunch will be taken with the youth leaders to provide for the kids)
Tues 6 th / Wed 7 th July	Across these two days, the onsite arts and crafts will be inspired by the theme of under the sea. We will also be engaging in different sporting activities such as badminton and team sports. The activities will begin 10am, pause during lunch between 12-1pm and resume until pick up time at 2pm.
Thurs 8 th August	The offsite trip to TCR HUB is to be confirmed. We will ensure you are informed in due course if we have to change to a different offsite trip or are in fact attending TCR HUB. All will be informed well in advance before the day itself, and any information about requirements for this day trip will also be sent out.
Tues 13 th / Wed 14 th August	Across these two days, the onsite arts and crafts will be inspired by the theme of Super Heroes. We will also be engaging in different sporting activities of the kids preferred choice after several weeks of trialing new games. The activities will begin 10am, pause during lunch between 12-1pm and resume until pick up time at 2pm.
Thurs 15 th August	The offsite trip to Infinite Air will take place all day, a bus will collect kids and staff from TCCA car park at 9:30am. The day consists of the kids having access to all courses of the trampoline park, refreshments will be accessible at the meeting point with the staff. (Lunch will be provided at the site before we return to TCCA)

- Please send your child with suitable shoes and clothing for indoor and outdoor activities e.g., water proof coat, sunscreen and a hat if needed.
- Please do not bring your child and/or allow them to come to the center before 9:30am to give staff time to prepare and set up.
- Please ensure we have the most up to date contact number in case of emergencies.
- Please send your child with water/bottle.
- You will be given a two-week food menu for your child's lunch. Please ensure we have the correct information on your child's dietary requirements.
- There will be a tuck shop provided at the end of each session, it is not compulsory for your child to bring money, however they are welcome to bring extra money to purchase something.
